**YOUR APPOINTMENT is** \_\_\_\_\_

**Please follow guidelines below to avoid being fined \$100.00 a day.**

As a resident of New Haven you are responsible for the pile at your address. You are allowed up to six tires, removed from rims, two major appliances with doors removed, and 750 pounds of bulk trash. You will be charged for piles over 750 at \$0.05 per pound.

**State law requires that all doors must be removed from all appliances**

- Place bulk trash at curb no earlier than 24 hours before appointment and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the day of your scheduled appointment.
- Place metal items and tires in separate piles segregated from other bulk items.
- Place trash so that it is accessible to heavy equipment vehicles and Public Works bulk pickup staff. Please be sure that the pile is **not blocked by cars, trees, or signs**.

**UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS for Bulk Pick Up (Turn over to see items)** \_\_\_\_\_➔

- Yard waste such as grass, branches or leaves.
- Household hazardous waste materials such as paint and aerosol spray cans, motor oil, oil-based paint, car batteries or anything that contains or has contained chemicals.
- Corrugated cardboard boxes, or any other recyclable items that DPW collects on regular refuse collection days.
- Construction or demolition debris (wood, fencing, roof shingles, sheetrock, masonry, toilets, tubs, and sinks) may be properly disposed of through the use of our Transfer Station located at 260 Middletown Avenue, New Haven, CT for a charge of \$0.05 per pound.
- Electronics, microwaves and air conditioners.

**Bulk Drop off Services** are also available for residents. Pick up free coupons at **DPW Office**.

Household hazardous waste should be taken to **Haz-waste Central** located at the Regional Water Authority, 90 Sargent Drive every Saturday from May until October between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 pm excluding holiday weekends. For more information: 203-401-2712.
