Employee Mandatory COVID-19 Vaccination & Testing Policy

Fire Training Academy Testing Procedures

1. An Employee COVID-19 PCR Test Site is located at:
New Haven Fire Training Academy, 230 Ella T. Grasso Blvd, New Haven CT 06519.
Only Employees in the Testing Pool may use this Test Site.
2. **This Test Site is a drive-thru operation.** Please **do not** exit your vehicle. All employees (and passengers) are required to wear a mask at this test center, except when performing the actual nasal swabbing part of the test.
3. The hours of operation are **Monday and Tuesday 8:30 AM – 4:30 PM.**
4. Upon arrival to the Academy, vehicles will **follow the arrows** and enter the testing line by staying to the **left** of the cones, and loop around to the first office trailer to provide the following information:
 - a) A copy of your **employee ID** card. Your employee ID is key to the information needed.
 - b) Please provide your **date of birth** and contact information as requested.Once this information is provided you will receive a label to affix to your swab sample tube once the test is completed.
5. You will then drive to the next office trailer to conduct the test. This is a nasal swab and it is self-administered by following the instructions of the testing technician. Once completed, you will place the swab in the provided test tube, and is left with the testing technician. You may then exit the Academy.
6. The test is processed by Quest Diagnostics. Results are provided within 24-36 hours of the test
 - a) Results will be available online with MyQuest.questdiagnostics.com (Employee will need to register with Quest Diagnostics.)
 - b) Trailer ONE will provide you with a flyer with the above information.
 - c) **The employee must then submit their test results via the [Weekly Testing Results Portal](#).**
7. The total time of providing information and testing is approximately 5-10 minutes on site.
